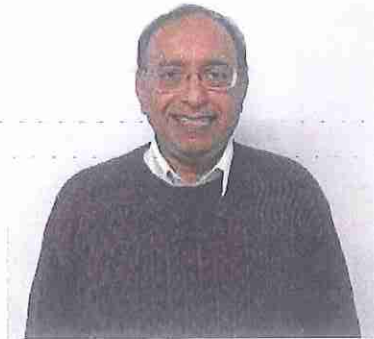

FDA to Proceed with Obama Era Nutritional Labeling Changes

In 2016, first lady Michelle Obama led the reform to update the nutrition facts label displayed on packaged foods in an attempt to provide greater transparency to consumers. Major changes included the removal of Vitamin A and C from the mandatory label, and the addition of Potassium, Vitamin D, and Added Sugar, with enforcement expected to begin July 2018.

Following a 1 year delay, the FDA has now reaffirmed its commitment to these changes, extending the enforcement deadline to January 1, 2020 for manufacturers with \$10 million or more in annual food revenue and January 1, 2021 for manufacturers \$10 million or less in annual food revenue.
